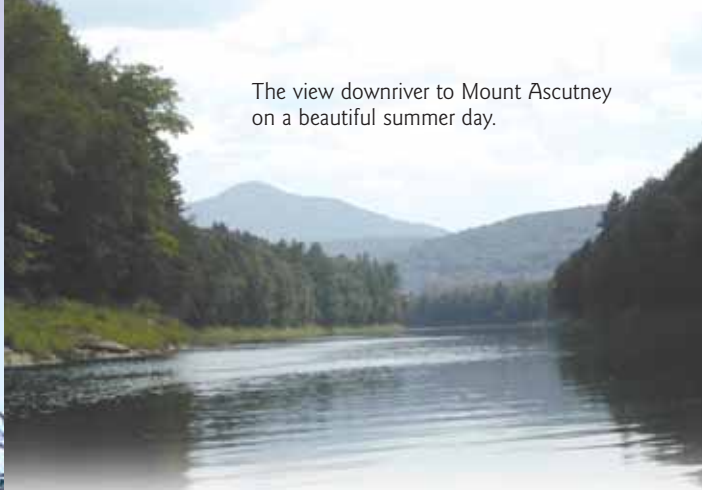

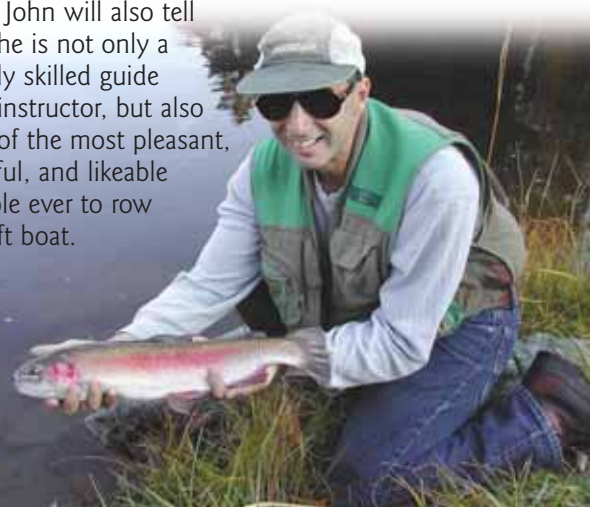

Fishing Float Trips

Whether you choose a combination trout/bass trip, or concentrate strictly on the Connecticut River's incredible smallmouth bass, John Marshall's 15 years of guiding will give you your best opportunity to land one of the Connecticut's fine fish.



Knowledgeable, patient, and courteous, John is an excellent teacher, and loves the chance to guide beginners and advanced anglers alike. Families and couples are welcome. Whether you like to spin fish or fly cast, John has equipment on board for your use, including fine fly rods by Orvis and Sage, plus all lures and flies.

The Connecticut River below Wilder Dam is home to Brook, Rainbow, and Brown trout ranging from eight inches to over twenty inches, plus smallmouth bass that average over 2 lbs and have been caught over 5 lbs. They'll give you an incredible fight on light tackle, often leaping several times. John knows all the best spots, along with what the fish are likely to be eating.

Great Food!

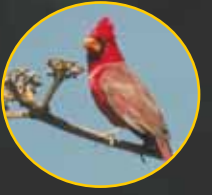

Enjoy a half day or 6 hour float on the beautiful Connecticut River below Wilder Dam. The finest binoculars by Swarovski & Zeiss will be available for your use, plus a Zeiss spotting scope to bring birds and wildlife practically into your lap.

Possible sightings include bald eagles, hawks, ospreys, ducks and geese in season, kingfishers, great blue herons, shore birds and songbirds. Also making occasional appearances are deer, otter, mink, weasel, muskrat, beaver, and turtles.



Shoreside plants offer spots of color, and in the fall, the foliage alone is worth the trip!
